# CAMPOUT

Friday Through Sunday, September 10-12, 2010  
Shake Campground (in Mountain Home State Forest)

Shake Campground is a free public campground in Mountain Home State Forest, 44 miles (1½ hours) East of Porterville, California. Take Highway 190 East from Porterville. Just past Springville turn left on Balch Park Road (at the “White Barn”). After 24 miles of winding road up the mountain, turn left on Camp Lena Road (just past the “Old Mountain Home Picnic Area”). Follow the signs to Shake Campground, about 2½ miles further. There are no stores (or gas) past Springville. For those unfamiliar with “real” ☺ camping, this is fairly primitive, with only drinking water and nice pit toilets available. But it’s **FREE!** The elevation is nearly 6,500 feet above sea level, and nights will likely be cold. Precipitation is also possible (though unlikely). Shake Campground is not a group campground (although we may have to have more than one family per camp-site), and we do not have space reserved. The higher-demand camping season will be past, but please be aware there may possibly be other campers (including non-believers) in the campground.
